47		RESTORING BOAT TO READY STATE

- The following procedure is in place to ensure that after an operation or shift the rescue boat is made ready for service.
- After recovery and turn-around the Lifeboat and launch vehicle must be prepared to a ready state and the Co-ordinating Authority informed.
- All crew and shore crew are able to assist in any part of the procedure.
- The post recovery checklists should be checked and signed by duty helm and tractor driver.
- It is most important that not only are the subjects checked, but that any defects, missing equipment or other failures that can not be immediately resolved be reported to the coxswain.
- Details of equipment and spare parts used should be reported to the equipment officer so that the inventory can be maintained.
- The Operations log should also be updated.
- The Radio log should also be updated.
